WHEEL OF COLOR

Daniel Smith Tube Watercolors

After a careful review of my big wheel of color, I decided to downsize from a 122-well palette to a 77-well palette. (Available at Robax.com) It was time to remove the colors that no longer work in my color-filled world. Criteria for removal:

- ✓ Boring?
- ✓ Repetitive?
- ✓ Doesn't work in pan format*

**Some tube colors don't reactivate well as pans. I don't use them straight out of the tube, they may be beautiful, but they must work as a pan.*

In addition to the downsizing, I decided to organize the colors by creating color wheel rather than going in the order of the Daniel Smith color chart. I placed neutrals in the center and worked my way out, grouping like colors together in like a slice of pie to create a better workflow.
